**OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

**Subject: Grant of Conveyance Allowance at the revised rates to Central Health Service (CHS) doctors working in Hospital/Dispensaries/Stores in CGHS Units under Central Government – regarding.**

The undersigned is directed to refer to para 11 of OM of even number dated 01.12.2021 issued by the Ministry on the above mentioned subject, vide which effective date of the said OM has been stated as 01.07.2017, and to say that in view of the change in criteria for grant of conveyance allowance to CHS doctors from Average Monthly Travel on Official Duty to number of domiciliary visits/hospital visits outside normal office hours vide above referred OM, this Ministry is in receipt of representation(s) seeking clarification whether in view of the instructions dated 01.12.2021 the cases of doctors who have already drawn their conveyance allowance as per old criteria for the period from 01.07.2017 to 30.11.2021 are required to be reopened or be considered as settled.

2 The matter has been examined by the Ministry and it has been observed that Hospitals/units may not have the details available with them regarding new criteria for grant of conveyance allowance to CHS doctors i.e. number of visits undertaken by CHS doctors during the period from 01.07.2017 to 30.11.2021. It is, therefore, clarified that the cases for grant of conveyance allowance to CHS doctors which have already been settled prior to issue of the OM dated 01.12.2021 need not to be reopened and the same may be treated as settled.
